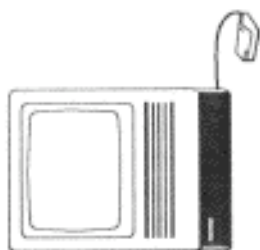

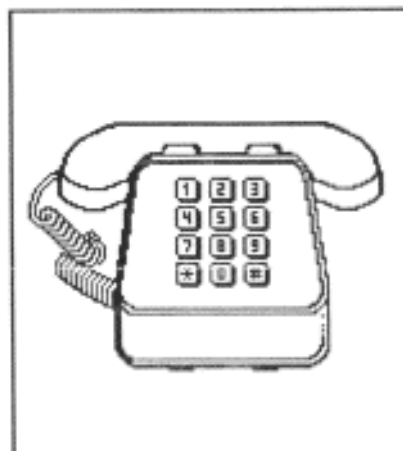

### June Meeting Features Telecommunications

The general membership meeting scheduled for next Wednesday evening, June 26, will be devoted to the subject of telecommunications

Slated is a demonstration of the MaUse/DRAUG Bulletin Board System as well as the CompuServe Information System. The MaUse BBS will be accessed using a simple communication program available on this month's Shareware disk. CompuServe will be accessed using CompuServe Navigator, a more sophisticated but specialized program which automates almost every action the user wishes to take while online.

Many Macintosh owners have never experienced telecommunications because they do not own a modem, the necessary piece of hardware which makes it all possible. Unfortunately, without a modem, it's difficult to experience for yourself just what can be done with on. June's



meeting will be an opportunity for everyone to see examples of just what is available over a telephone line to your Macintosh.

The meeting will be held at the usual location in Brooklyn. Early birds are welcome at 7:00 PM with the formal meeting commencing at 7:30 PM. See you there!

### Double - Click Rises From The Ashes!!!

The June issue of Double-Click is being created in a new desktop publishing program from Silicon Beach Software called Personal Press™.

Personal Press™ is designed to fill the needs of organizations such as MaUse in producing publications quickly. It lacks some of the "high

end" features of the more well known DTP programs but offers low cost, ease of use, and an AutoCreate function which can literally strip hours off the time required to put together a monthly newsletter such as Double-Click.

We hope that Personal Press™ will help us solve our longstanding problem of reaching our members with regular and timely information by means of our newsletter.

## System 7.0 Available Through MaUsE

Apple Canada has clarified its position regarding User Group distribution of System 7.0 software since our May membership meeting.

MaUsE has received a complete set (9 Disks!!) of System 7.0 software. We ARE allowed to distribute copies of this software to MaUsE members. We are required to provide members who receive System 7.0 in this way with a copy of the System Software Distribution Agreement between MaUsE and Apple Canada and we are required to give Apple Canada the recipient members' names.

The large number of disks involved makes it impractical to copy disks at the membership meetings or to have supplies on hand. We therefore ask members who wish to obtain System 7.0 to contact Librarian Bruce Cameron to make arrangements.

MaUsE will also be receiving one copy of the System 7.0 manuals but we are NOT permitted to distribute these. This method of System Software distribution does NOT provide members with all items included in the Personal Upgrade Kit (eg. HyperCard, Free Support, etc.).

## SYMANTEC RELEASES SAM 3.0

CUPERTINO, Calif. --

March 18, 1991 --

Symantec Corporation today announced the release of Symantec Anti-Virus for Macintosh (SAM), version 3.0.

SAM 3.0 includes power and usability enhancements to its popular SAM Intercept and SAM Virus Clinic features, including more flexible detection and protection algorithms. In addition, SAM 3.0 gives users the ability to receive free repair and easily update as new viruses are discovered.

"SAM has proven itself to be invaluable to all types of Macintosh users," said Gordon E. Eubanks Jr., president and CEO of Symantec Corporation. "The growth of viruses in the MAC environment has created a situation where effective system virus protection is a necessity, not a luxury."

Several features in version 3.0 are designed to make the software easier to use and more efficient. SAM 3.0 includes a separate virus definition file so users need only update one file, making it easier to update single systems or networks. Symantec now offers the ability to download the definition file directly from their Bulletin Board System (BBS) or by contacting the 24 hour Virus News Line.

To update a network, the network administrator need only update the latest definition file. Users then download this file into their system folder and restart.

Version 3.0 also includes the ability to scan all volumes or single volumes directly from the Control Panel, automatically disinfect any infected desktop file, includes timed macros for automatic scanning, and faster scanning performance. SAM 3.0 detects 36 known viruses, strains and Trojan Horses.

SAM 3.0 will support Apple System 7.0 architecture, creating added user benefits. For example, with System 7.0, SAM 3.0 has the ability to scan any Desk Accessory

also includes a new feature called "SAM Intercept Jr.". This is a scaled down ("Junior") version of the SAM Intercept module. Designed especially for systems with limited memory and disk space, it needs only 11K of memory and 19K on disk to run. Responsible for scanning every application (INIT, etc.) at launch, as well as every floppy at insertion, SAM Intercept Jr. also scans and disinfects infected desktop files.

SAM 3.0 is now available from Symantec through its international network of software dealers and distributors and works with any Macintosh.

The suggested retail price of SAM 3.0 is \$99.00\*. For \$29.00\*, users of previously released versions of SAM can upgrade their software.

(DA) for viruses at launch. For added ease, users can drag one or more files to the SAM Virus Clinic icon, let go, and Virus Clinic will scan those files immediately. Also, updating virus definition files will be done automatically when System 7.0 resides on the network. Users who update from Apple System 6.0 to System 7.0 will find their regular dialogue help screens transposed into balloon help and the old help dialogue screens automatically cleared from the program.

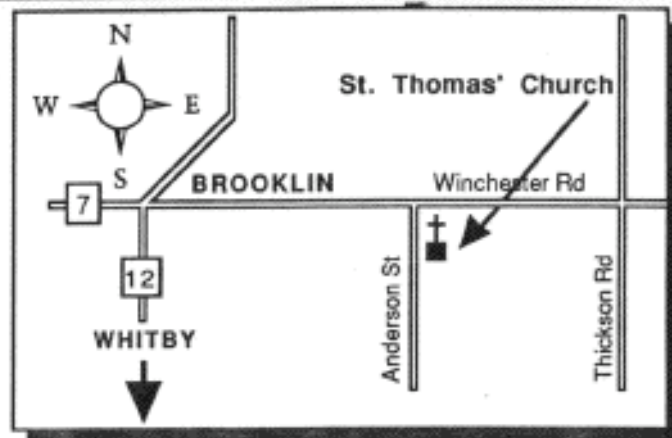
