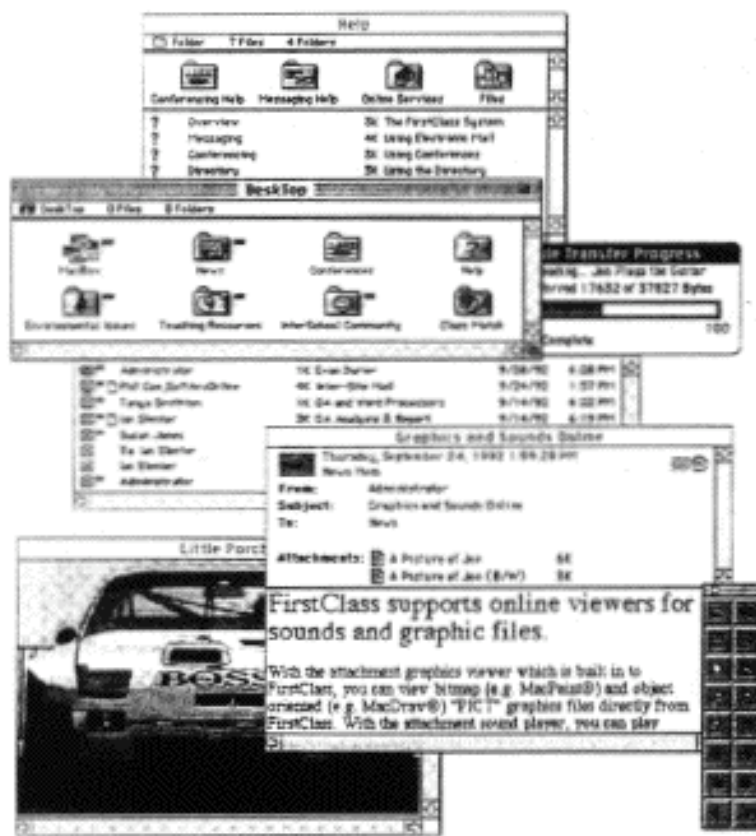

Note from the 401. its less than 2km. From Oshawa its 55km and travel time is 30 minutes.

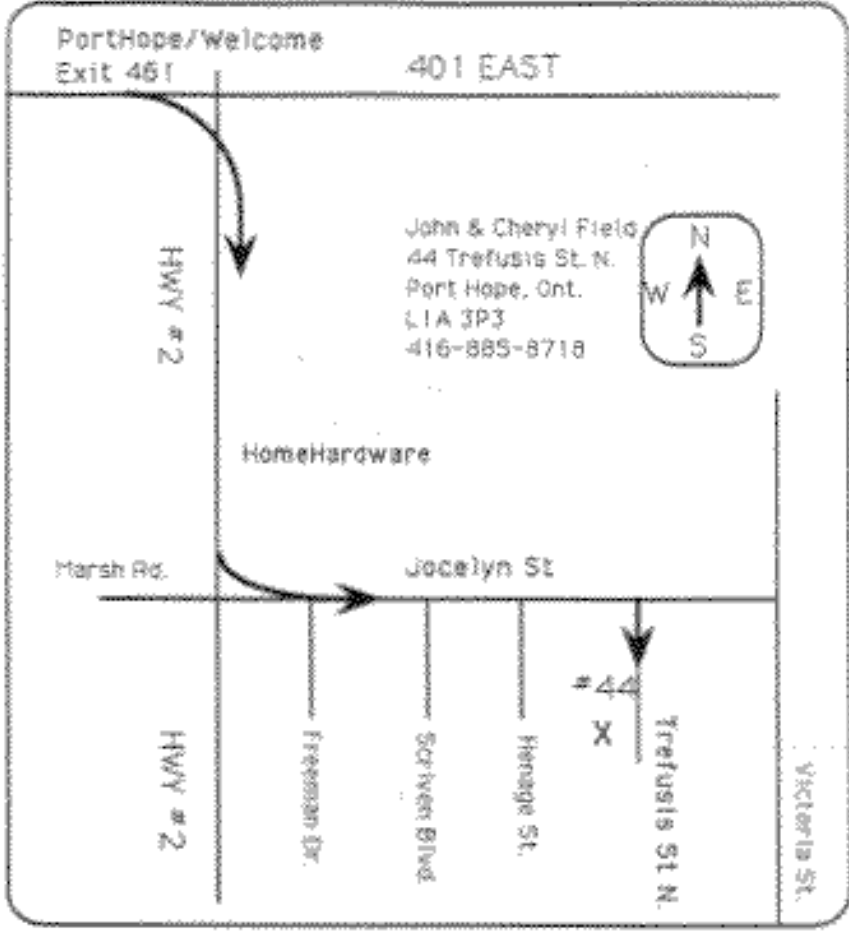

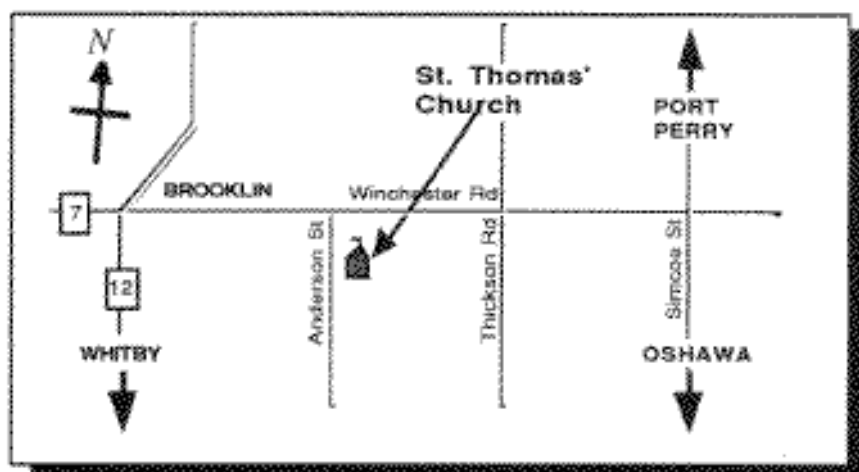
